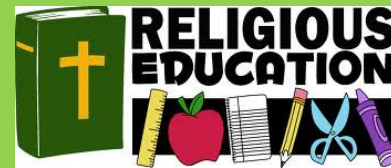


Bingo is held every Tuesday evening in the auditorium starting at 7:30 PM. Early bird is at 7:15 PM. Doors open at 6:00 PM.

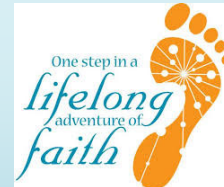

GRADES KINDERGARTEN THROUGH 8th

School will begin for grades **Kindergarten through 8th** on Thursday, September 8, 2016. Students can arrive for line-up in the playground no earlier than 7:40 am. School will begin at 7:55 am. Dismissal will be at 2:30 pm. Kindergarten students line-up in the fenced area on Peter Ave.. In the case of inclement weather, students will line up in the cafeteria at designated tables. Students will enter through the front door on Penn Ave. Parents are not permitted to enter the school building at drop off. Students are expected to be in full **SPRING** uniform. The hot lunch program will be available on September 8th and 9th.



PRE-K FOR ALL/ UNIVERSAL PRE-K (4 YEAR OLD PROGRAM)

School will begin for **Pre-K for all/ Universal Pre-K (4 year old program)** on Thursday, September 8, 2016. Teachers will be sending more information through the mail prior to the beginning of the school year. School will begin for **Pre-Kindergarten**: 3 year olds on Monday, September 12, 2016 (M-W-F session only) and Tuesday, September 13, 2016 (T-Tr. Session only). The morning session runs from 8:15 am to 10:45 am and the afternoon session runs from 12:00 pm to 2:30 pm. Students must be in full uniform. Students will enter and dismiss through the castle doors on Penn Ave.
